#### NETWORK and WiFi:

Your laptop, tablet, and other mobile devices can be connected to wireless network in KEK and J-PARC during the school. The eduroam is a wifi service, which can be accessed from most of KEK/Tsukuba campus including dormitory. There are some locations where the eduroam signal is weak or not available where we provide alternative wifi services.

For those who already have a valid eduroam account in your home institute, one can connect the eduroam wifi network with your own account. If not, we'll provide an account for each participant. No prior application for network connection is necessary.

#### MONEY:

Please note that all service (including hotel, meals, etc.) in Japan can be paid in Japanese Yen (JPY) only.

Since Bank nor ATM is not very convenient (~2km apart) in the surrounding area as shown in the map enclosed, we recommend you to make money exchange at the airport. For you information, average daily cost for the meals would be around 1,500-2,000 JPY.

#### INSURANCE:

During the school period from 12 to 22 Mar. all the students staying in the KEK dormitory are covered by an insurance against their accidental injury/death. Since the coverage of the insurance is very limited, we recommend the students to have their own standard insurance for foreign travel during the whole period of their stay in Japan.
